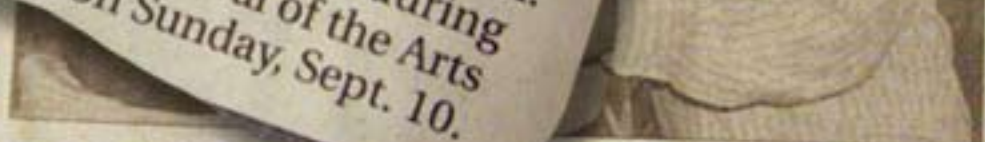


Images of Iceland
